

AGENCIES PRE-APPROVED FOR SUPPLEMENTAL SALARY FUNDING

The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences has approved the following granting agencies as offering nationally competitive awards or as national or internationally recognized institutes offering postdoctoral research appointments. College faculty members holding tenured or tenure-track positions who have completed at least one full academic year of teaching, research, and service at KU are eligible for [Supplemental Salary Funding \(SSF\)](#) support when offered awards from these agencies that cover at least 50% of their academic year or semester base salary. College faculty hoping to obtain SSF support from agencies that are not on this list, but which offer awards that otherwise meet the SSF criteria should contact their Associate Dean regarding eligibility *before* applying. Faculty in other units should contact their Dean's office to learn what granting agencies are considered eligible for SSF. To apply for SSF support, see the [SSF Application Procedures](#). Please note that, regardless of whether a fellowship is on this list, if the award does not meet the SSF criteria (see policy) SSF support will not be granted.
