

## AGENCIES PRE-APPROVED FOR SUPPLEMENTAL SALARY FUNDING

The College of Liberal Arts and Sciences has approved the following granting agencies as offering fellowships eligible for Supplemental Salary Funding (SSF). Faculty members in the College who win fellowships from these agencies *which pay at least half of their academic year salary in cases of full year fellowships or at least half of their semester salary in cases of half year fellowships* should follow the procedures outlined in the Supplemental Salary Funding Policy to apply for SSF assistance. Faculty hoping to obtain SSF support for fellowships **not** on this list, but otherwise meeting the criteria, should contact their Associate Dean regarding eligibility **before** applying for the fellowship.
